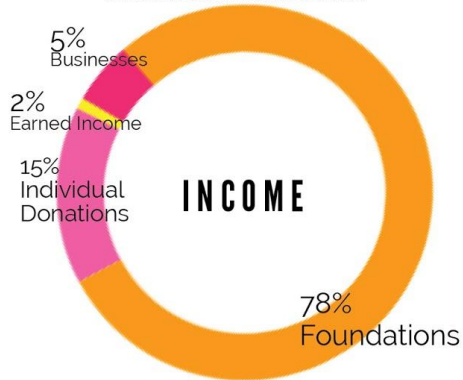
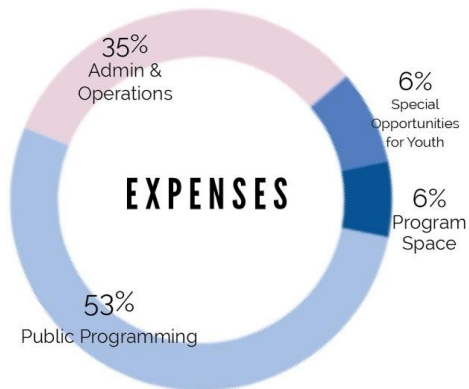


FINANCIAL HEALTH
